

The APHG supports Euroclio conference to take place in Marseille in 2018

The History and Geography Teachers' Association (Association des Professeurs d'Histoire et de Géographie – APHG) and its regional counterpart in Aix Marseille have been selected to coordinate the annual Euroclio conference that will take place in Marseille in 2018. Dedicated to the Mediterranean region – the conference shall be entitled "The Mediterranean, casting light on Europe. Meetings, exchanges, migrations, conflicts and cultures" will be held in April 2018 for 5 days onward with more than 50 countries to be represented.

The APHG has been a member of Euroclio's European association since it was founded in 1992. Teachers from different European countries have come together to tackle punctual matters through Euroclio, aiming at building European history, going beyond strictly national issues. Such pedagogical projects are meant for secondary education and have yet another goal: abounding in documentary as well as pedagogical resources through the website *Historiana*, intended for all fellow European colleagues.

The point is to elaborate a truly European citizenship, not on what tears countries apart but rather on what holds them together in order to make a common space possible for all generations.

The APHG's site had already taken over from the on-going project it associated to back in October 2015. The project will be presented at the next Euroclio conference in San Sebastian, Spain, in 2017 (Autonomous Basque's Release).
